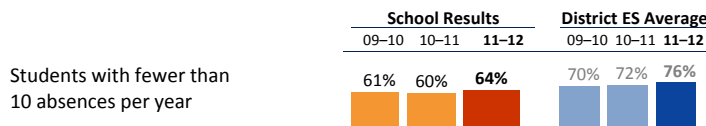

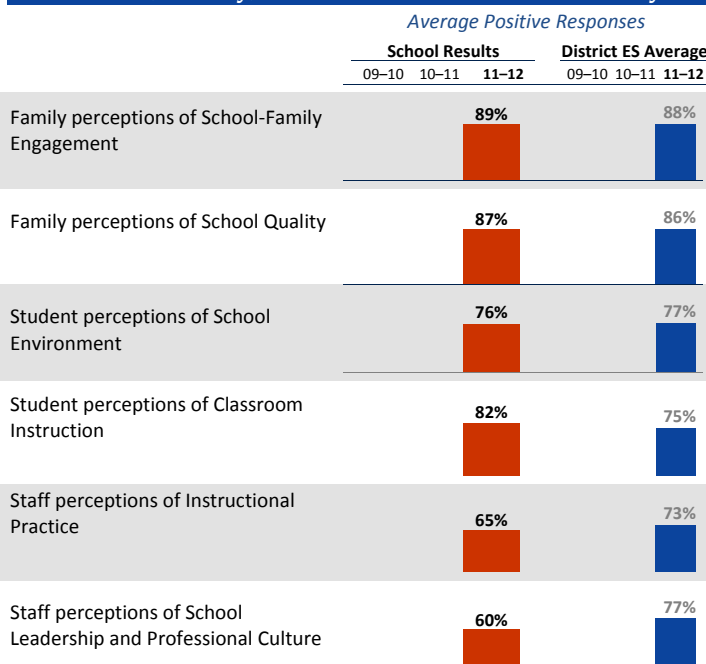

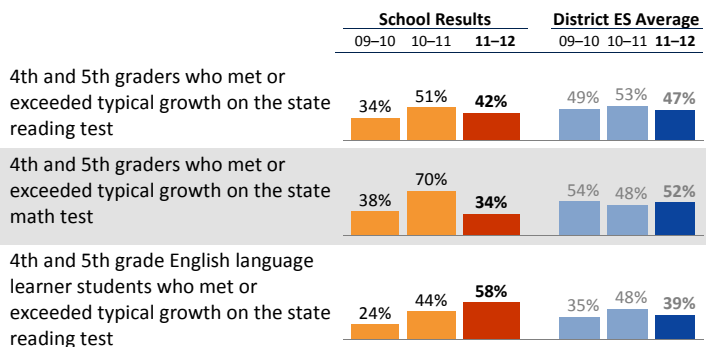
### Student, Family, and Staff School Climate Survey

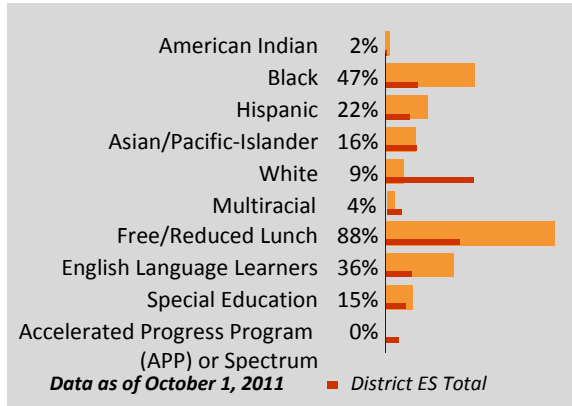

### Year-to-Year Growth: Following the Same Students



This measure shows how much growth students have achieved compared to similar students across the state in the same grade level. ### School Description and Plan to Achieve Goals

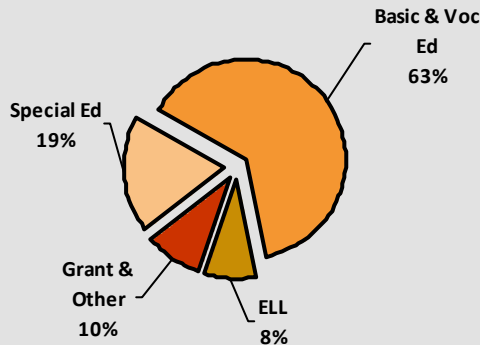
West Seattle Elementary is a highly diverse elementary school located in the High Point Neighborhood of West Seattle. We are in the third year of a 3 year SIG/MERIT grant. Our school has shown significant improvements in reading, math, discipline and attendance; though we are still below the district average.

The following is a partial list of strategies we have implemented to meet our goals for 2012-2013:

- Work in professional learning communities to use data to drive instruction
- Provide intensive intervention for students working below grade level as identified by DIBELS, MAP, Running Records and MSP
- Monitor student progress for a minimum of 3 to 5 times per year
- Provide professional development in intervention materials and strategies
- Establish a parent group to involve parents into the school
- Establish an attendance committee to meet on a weekly basis and monitor student attendance
- Provide opportunities for teachers to observe in other classrooms and to share professional practice
- Create curriculum maps to the Common Core Standards
